# Overstock expands, adds jobs to Customer Care Call Center at Satsop



*Only three months after its Grand Opening, the Evergreen Customer Care Call Center at the Satsop Business Park will be expanding to include the entire 43,000 sq. ft. Flex Tech Building and adding up to an additional 150 employees.*

Only three months after the Grand Opening of its Evergreen Customer Care Call Center at the Satsop Business Park, Overstock.com will be expanding their footprint to include the entire 43,000 square foot Flex Tech Building.

Overstock began making improvements to the lower floor of the building immediately after the lease amendment was approved by the Port Commission at its August meeting. They expect to hire up to an additional 150 new employees, some of which may be seasonal.

"Overstock has been such a great addition to the Park, and we are extremely excited to have them expand and add more jobs here in Grays

Harbor," shared Satsop Manager of Business Development Alissa Shay. "We are proud to have Overstock as a partner at the Park and in Grays Harbor," added Port Commission President Jack Thompson.

Overstock will again be tapping into the labor pool of the surrounding five-county region to hire for the additional positions. Hiring is already underway as they hope to be fully staffed and trained by October 15<sup>th</sup> for the busy holiday shopping season.

Overstock joins several other companies taking advantage of the unique assets at the Park including redundant power and fiber, turnkey office buildings, and a strategic location.

# BHP to hold open house for Terminal 3 potash export facility
